Fort Lee senior leaders signed the first pledges of financial support to kick-off the Army Emergency Relief Campaign at a Town Hall here today. Maj. Gen. Darrell Williams, Combined Arms Support Command and Fort Lee commanding general; Command Sgt. Maj. Nathaniel Bartee, senior CASCOM noncommissioned officer; Col. Paul Brooks, Fort Lee garrison commander and Command Sgt. Maj. Clarence Richardson, senior garrison noncommissioned officer, signed payroll deduction forms in front of a packed Lee Theater, setting the tone for the campaign that ends May 15.

AER funds provide emergency financial support, scholarships and low-interest loans for active duty soldiers, military retirees, surviving spouses and their dependents in crisis. These are the types of emergencies that arise suddenly, are unforeseen and require immediate attention, according to the Fort Lee Financial Readiness program manager, Juanita Lazenby.
